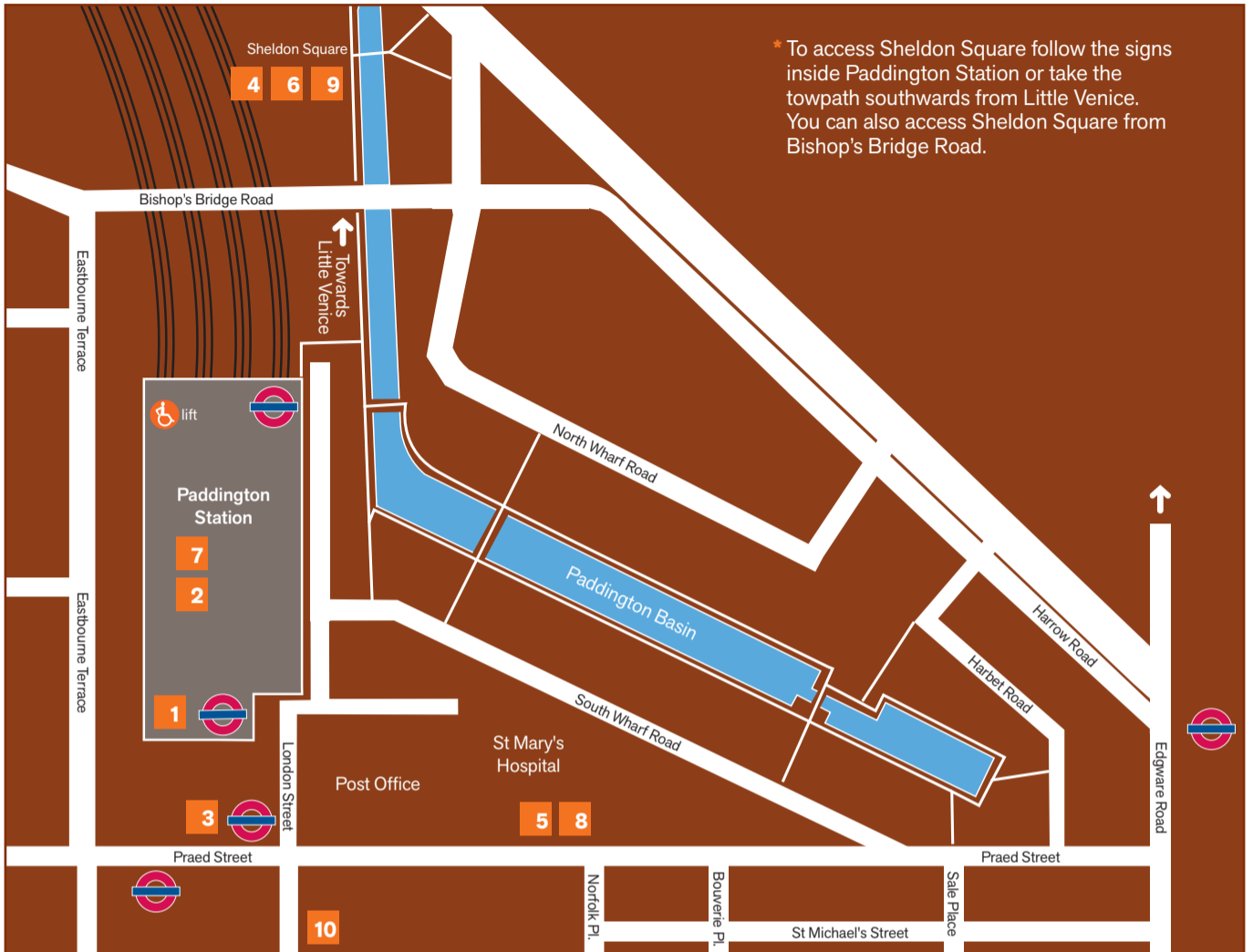

- 1 A Bear and a Boy that Never Grows Up** WITH BRYAN*
Meet at the Paddington Bear Statue near Yo Sushi! in Paddington Station.



From Paddington Bear to Peter Pan, with some real life animals along the way, this walk is for children, families and the young at heart. All children must be accompanied by an adult.

- 2 Brunel-guided Walk**
Meet at the Brunel Statue, Platform One, Paddington Station.



Meet Brunel and walk in his world, listen to chronicles of his extraordinary life and experience his passion for Paddington while you move through the ages. Back in the present, discover the changes taking place at today's Paddington Waterside.

- 3 Ducks and Duchesses** WITH BRYAN*
Meet in front of the Hilton London Paddington, 146 Praed Street.

Take a walk on the wild side and enjoy the delights of Paddington and Kensington Palace Gardens, while you hear stories of famous women who have lived in the area through the ages.

- 4 Exploring Little Venice** WITH BRYAN*
Meet outside Starbucks, Sheldon Square*, PaddingtonCentral.

Go back in time and delve into Paddington's vibrant history. Hear accounts of this delightful Victorian residential suburb, its architecture, charming café barges and natural beauty along the tranquil waterfront.

- 5 Fleming-guided Walk**
Meet at the arched gate to St Mary's Hospital, Praed Street, opposite the Fountains Abbey pub.



Meet Fleming, and hear first hand about life in the early 1900s, how he discovered penicillin, a life-saving drug which changed the course of history, and how he came to be one of the greatest scientists of the last century.

- 6 Introducing Paddington Waterside** WITH IMELDA
Meet outside Starbucks, Sheldon Square*, PaddingtonCentral.



Explore the fabulous new destination, location Paddington Waterside. Walk from Sheldon Square through to the foot of the Basin, including impressive bright new offices and homes, colourful barges, uniquely designed bridges and spectacular open spaces.

- 7 Paddington Literary Tour** WITH JOHN
Meet at the Lost Soldier Statue on Platform One, Paddington Station, next to the First Class Lounge.

This walk, new for 2007, will explore the rich literary history of the Paddington area, covering both authors that have lived locally, and those that have featured Paddington's colourful past in their writing.

- 8 Penicillin, Free Speech and the Hangman's Noose** WITH BRYAN*
Meet at the arched gate to St Mary's Hospital, Praed Street, opposite the Fountains Abbey pub.



From the triumph of Fleming at St Mary's to the tragedy of 20,000 souls hanged at Tyburn, and a lot more in between. Walk from St Mary's Hospital, through Norfolk Square and Hyde Park stables towards Marble Arch.

- 9 Quirky Shopping** WITH IMELDA
Meet outside Starbucks, Sheldon Square*, PaddingtonCentral.

Uncover the hidden treasures on offer in and around Paddington Waterside. Walk from Paddington, along Church Street to the world famous Alfie's Antique Market.

- 10 William Whiteley-guided Walk**
Meet at the entrance to Norfolk Square Gardens, London Street.



Enjoy a tour of Paddington by the founder of the famous Whiteley's Shopping Centre and hear about his extraordinary life, and untimely death at the hands of his son.
