

# A step-free route from the London Eye to Horse Guards Parade

This map starts at the heart of London's South Bank and goes over the Golden Jubilee bridge. It takes you to Horse Guard's Parade to see the Changing of the Guard, a ceremony well worth seeing. (Hourly from 10am - 4.00pm)

This journey is around 1450 metres long. It should take around 20 minutes to finish. If you have difficulty getting about it could take around 50 minutes. (These are estimates only.)

Under each picture is a time-bar to show you how long you need to walk to finish the journey.

 = the length of travel for each part of the journey.

 = the length of travel already completed.

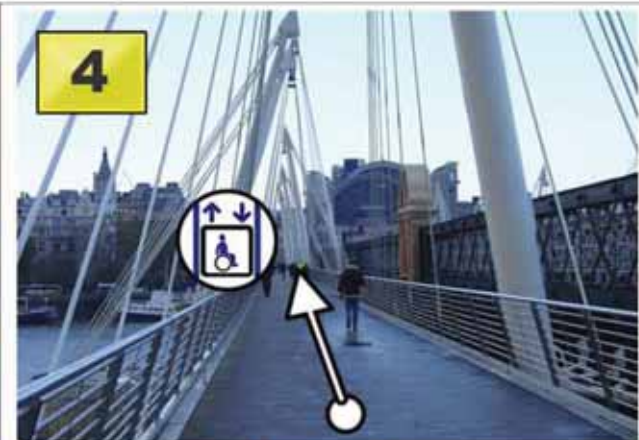

Turn **right** at the front of the **London Eye** (go **towards** the **Waterloo Millennium Pier**).

Follow the **riverside walk**. It's a **long walk** but with lots of **seats on the way**. The pavement is really wide and flat.

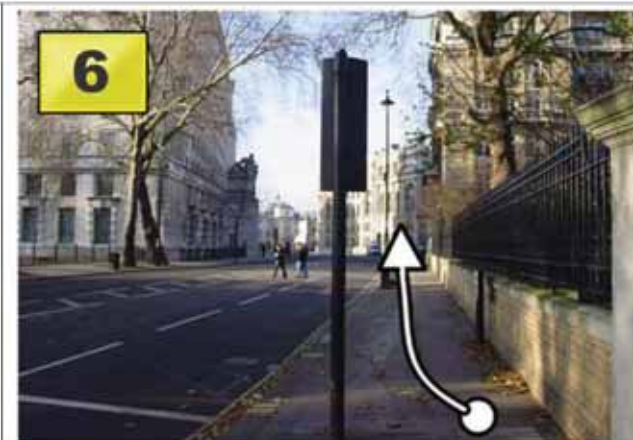
At the **1st Golden Jubilee Bridge** there is a **lift** on the right (**behind the steps**). Take the lift to **Level 1**.



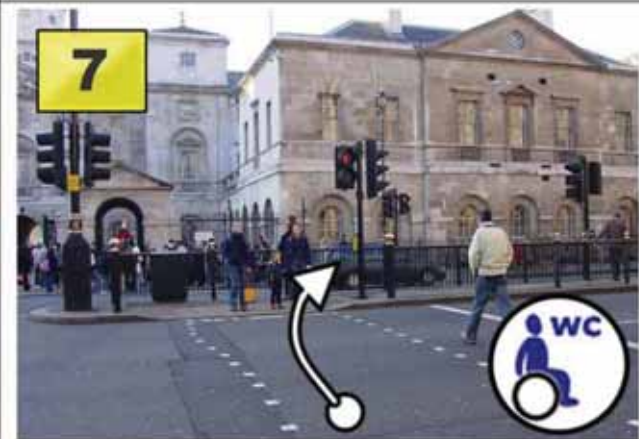
Go **across the bridge**. There is a **lift down** at the other end. Take it down to **street level**.



**Behind the lift** is a pelican **crossing over Northumberland Avenue** - here and go **along Victoria Embankment**.



Turn **right** and go along **Horse Guards Avenue**.





**Cross over Whitehall**.






Turn **left** towards **Horse Guards Building**.



Go **through the main gates** and arch to the courtyard to see **Horse Guards Parade**. Please note, gates close at 8.00pm.

**1**   Accessible toilets: 2 at the London Eye.  
Cafés: 2 Café Manga coffee shops, 1 inside the Ticket Hall and 1 outside.

**3**   Places to eat: Giraffe (☎020 7928 2004); Strada (☎020 7401 9126); Wagamama (☎020 7021 0877) and Eat (☎020 7401 2989).  
All with accessible toilets. The ramp with rails to this level is at the end of the shops.

**7**  Accessible toilet: at Banqueting House, Whitehall (☎020 7930 4179).
