

A step-free route from the National Film Theatre to Westminster Station




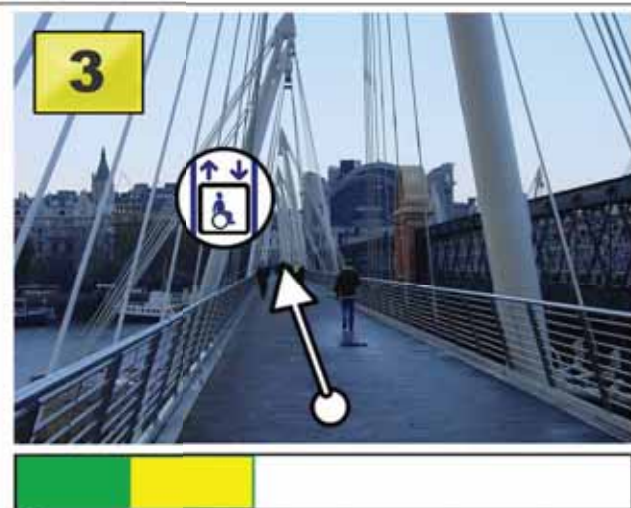
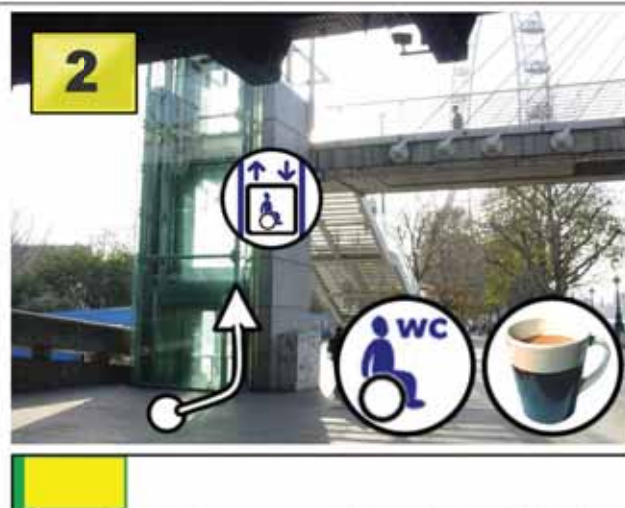


This map starts from the National Film Theatre on the South Bank of the Thames. It takes you to Westminster Underground Station (step-free access to the Jubilee Line). The route goes along the Golden Jubilee Bridge and the North bank of the Thames.

This journey is around 1500 metres long. It should take around 20 minutes to finish. If you have difficulty getting about it could take around 50 minutes. (These are estimates only.)

Under each picture is a time-bar to show you how long you need to walk to finish the journey.

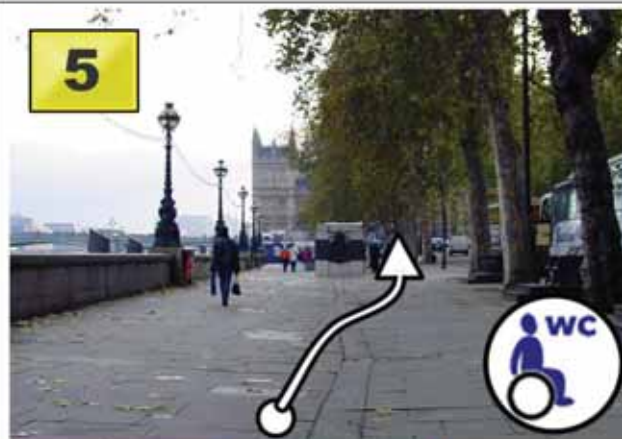
 = the length of travel for each part of the journey.  = the length of travel already completed.



From the National Film Theatre riverside entrance **turn left** and go under the bridge.

Pass the shops and cafes. On the left is a lift for the Golden Jubilee Bridge. Take the lift to Level 1.

Go across the bridge. There is a lift down at the other end. Take the lift down to street level.



Cross at the **crossing under the bridge**. Turn right and go along **Victoria Embankment**.

Further along the riverside the level splits - **stay on the upper level to cross the road** (the toilets are on the lower level).

Turn right and cross the pelican crossings at the end of the road. This gets quite busy.



Keep going **along Bridge Street** to Westminster Station.

On the **left of the station entrance** is a **lift to the Ticket Office**.

Go through the **ticket barriers**. **Straight ahead** is the **2nd lift** (take to the next level down).

From the lift **turn left** to the **3rd lift**.
Take the lift **down** to the **platform**.




From the lift **turn right** for the **platforms**.



1   Accessible toilets and Film Cafe (Café bar) at the National Film Theatre (☎ 020 7928 3232).

2   Places to eat: Giraffe (☎ 020 7928 2004); Strada (☎ 020 7401 9126); Wagamama (☎ 020 7021 0877) and Eat (☎ 020 7401 2989).
All with accessible toilets.
The ramp with rails to this level is at the end of the shops.

5  Accessible toilet: at Westminster Millennium Pier near Victoria Embankment (on the lower walkway level) - RADAR key operated.

7  Caffé Nero by Westminster Station (☎ 020 7925 0781).
